THE CONTINGENCY FUND OF MEGHALAYA (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2014

An Ordinance

further to amend temporarily the Contingency Fund of Meghalaya Act, 1972.

Whereas, the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya is not in session and I am satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for me to take immediate action;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution, I, Dr.K.K. Paul, the Governor of Meghalaya am pleased to promulgate in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India the following Ordinance, namely,-

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Contingency Fund of Meghalaya (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of proviso to section 2 of Meghalaya Act 5 of 1972.

2. In section 2 of the Contingency Fund of Meghalaya Act, 1972 as amended, for the existing proviso, the following new proviso, shall be substituted, namely,-

“ Provided that during the period beginning on the date of commencement of the Contingency Fund of Meghalaya (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 and ending the 31st March 2015, this section shall have effect subject to modification that for the words “one hundred and five crores”, the words “six hundred and five crores” shall be substituted”.
