| <b>Insertion of new Section 3D.</b>                                     | 2. After Section 3C of the Meghalaya Amusements and Betting Tax Act (Assam Act VI of 1939 as adapted by Meghalaya), the following new Section 3D, shall be inserted, namely:-   |
| <b>“Power of State Government to amend and revise the rates of Tax.</b> | “3D. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the State Government may, subject to previous publication of its intention to do so, by notification in the Official Gazette add to, omit or otherwise modify and revise the rate of tax in respect of the Meghalaya Amusements and Betting Tax Act and there upon it shall stand modified or revised, as the case may be, accordingly”. |

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Meghalaya in the fifty eight year of republic of India as follows:-

Short title and  
Commencement

1. (i) This Act may be called the Meghalaya Appropriation (No.II) Act, 2007
- (ii) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, 2007.

Withdrawal of Rs.3487,81,25,000 from and out of the consolidated fund of Meghalaya for the financial year 2007-2008

2. From and out of the Consolidated fund of Meghalaya there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the schedule amounting in the aggregate inclusive of sums specified in column (3) of the schedule to the Meghalaya Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 2007 to the sum of Rs. Three thousand four hundred eighty seven crores, eighty one lakhs twenty five thousand towards defraying several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending on their thirty first day of March, 2008 in respect of the services specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
